5th Annual Gulf Coast Art Show (2020)

February 15th – May 8th

Dates to Remember:

February 10, 2020	Artwork must be turned in to the Museum of the Gulf Coast ON OR BEFORE this day.
February 15, 2020	Art Show Opening and Reception , 10am – 2pm
February 29, 2020	Family Fun Day Contest Judging and Awards , 10am – 2pm
May 22, 2020	ALL SUBMITTED ARTWORK MUST BE PICKED UP BY THIS DAY

Artwork Rules:

- Up to (2) two entries per person will be accepted.
- All 2D entries must be ready to hang, either framed, mounted to board, or on canvas. Loose paper will not be accepted.
- 3D entries cannot exceed 24” height.
- All entries must have a registration form from the Museum of the Gulf Coast taped to the back of 2D or bottom of 3D pieces.
- Entries may be of any medium the artist chooses, but may not include food products.
- The theme of the show is “A Look to the Future”. All artwork should keep with this theme featuring futuristic technologies, space travel, and other science fiction scenarios. The Museum reserves the right to refuse work which it deems inappropriate for exhibition.
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Competition entries will premiere at the Museum of the Gulf Coast and winners will be announced on Family Fun Day, February 29, 2020 10am-2pm. *** Artwork must be turned in to the Museum of the Gulf Coast ON OR BEFORE February 10, 2020, to guarantee being hung for the opening.**

- Children’s Competition** is FREE to enter. Prizes will be awarded.
 - oChildren 6 years and under
 - oChildren 7 – 12 years
 - oTeens 12 - 18 years
- Adult Competition** Entry Fee is \$10 which will go towards the “Best in Show” CASH PRIZE. For purposes of this competition, a non-professional artist is defined as someone who has not sold artwork or previously had an exhibition.

Adult Division 1 – Non-Professional **Adult Division 2** – Professional

Teens 12+ years may choose to pay the \$10 entry fee and enter the Adult Non-Professional Division.

All artists may sell their work. The Museum accepts a 15% commission. Artists will be paid via check at the end of the competition.
